Thank you for taking time to stop and realize what important work we have done, thanks to YOU! Can you believe that our foundation has been touching lives for almost 20 years? That's right, 20 years!

Thanks to you we have been strong and steady in our efforts to provide comfort, in many shapes and forms, to thousands of patients and their families facing the battle that leukemia and bone marrow transplants bring their way. We have always been able to say "yes" and give what they need to offer relief. Over 150 Comfort bags were delivered to patients since the beginning of the pandemic. Thanks to donors like you the Michael Flanagan Foundation has been able to fulfill an amazing amount of grants and help so many in their struggle with cancer.



The Michael H. Flanagan Foundation was established by the Flanagan family in 2002 in memory of this young man, who at the age of 19 was diagnosed with leukemia. Michael strived to live his life with courage, integrity and faith during his three and a half year struggle with leukemia which included two bone marrow transplants. He received the very best in medical and nursing care at both The Miriam Hospital in Rhode Island and the Tufts Medical Center in Boston.

Bone Marrow transplant patients spend weeks and sometimes months in isolation while they struggle with complications and wait for their new immune system to develop. After witnessing Michael's time in the hospital, his family decided to establish this foundation as a way to keep his memory alive and to support other patients facing the same difficult journey. It is the mission of the Foundation to provide comfort to these patients and their families during this very challenging time.

In 2020 we gave twenty-one grants totaling \$15,000 and so far this year we have filled 28 grants totaling \$22,000! This is money that goes directly into the hands of those who need it most. We are also proud to have provided Reiki training for nurses at Tufts Medical Center as well as our multiple education grants.

You may recall that our fall 2020 benefit was postponed and the entertaining Flanafest concert kicked off our fundraising efforts of 2020. We hope to gather in 2022 to mark 20 years. Stay tuned! As always, we appreciate your ongoing support and the big difference you help us make every day.

A SPECIAL LEGACY


Renaming of The Michael H. Flanagan Foundation Educational Advancement Fund

The Flanagan family was so pleased with the care Michael received from the nurses at The Miriam Hospital and Tufts Medical Center that they decided to establish a fund to further nursing education. Since 2014 this fund has been awarded to an RN/BSN who has consistently exceeded expectations in providing patient care in the area of Oncology.

This year the Michael H. Flanagan Foundation has decided to rename our Education Advancement Fund award to honor the memory of Susan Farley. Sue passed away in January at the age of 48 after a long battle with leukemia. Sue's loss leaves a hole in the heart of all who knew and loved her. Wife to Kevin and loving mom to five children, Sue leaves a tremendous legacy.

Our connection began when she was diagnosed in 2014. That year, Sue and her family spent Thanksgiving in the Hospital Oncology Family Room which the Flanagan Foundation had recently refurbished. In 2015 her daughter Grace created a senior project "Feet for Defeat", which raised awareness for leukemia and created a fundraiser benefitting the Flanagan Foundation.

In 2018. Kevin and Sue were guest speakers at our bi-annual benefit and just this October Sue's daughter Caroline ran the 2021 Boston Marathon in her mom's memory and raised awareness for the Flanagan Foundation! Sue embodied courage, integrity and faith - Michael's defining characteristics. Based



on her wonderful legacy, the Foundation is pleased to name this award in her memory.


